The IPA Investigations Review Officer and the IPA Investigations Officer resolved that Mr. Mutch had a case to answer for having:

- (a) breached Clause 98(1) of the IPA Constitution in that it was alleged he had been convicted by a Court of Law of an offence inconsistent with being a member of the Institute in that it was alleged that he had been convicted in the High Court of Fiji at Suva of a total of six charges;
- (b) breached Clause 98(2)(c) of the IPA Constitution in that it was alleged he obtained admission to this Institute by improper means; and
- (c) breached Clause 98(2)(f) of the IPA Constitution in that it was alleged that the aforementioned, both joint and several, constituted conduct that is not in the best interests of the Institute.

Tribunal Decision

The Tribunal of 28th September 2012 resolved that the cases as presented against Mr. Mutch under sections 98(1) and 98(2)(f) of the IPA Constitution were proven. The case as presented under section 98(2)(c) was unproven.

The Tribunal further resolved that Mr. Mutch's membership of the IPA is forfeit.
