The IPA Investigations Review Officer and the IPA Investigations Officer resolved that the member had a case to answer for having:

- (a) breached clause 98(2)(b) of the IPA Constitution in that it was alleged the member failed to observe a proper standard of professional care, skill or competence in that it was alleged the member provided incorrect advice on a deduction for superannuation thus resulting in a financial penalty for a client; and
- (b) breached clause 98(2)(f) of the IPA Constitution in that it was alleged that the above constitutes conduct that is not in the best interests of the Institute.

Tribunal Decision

The Tribunal of 19th October 2012 resolved that the case as presented against the member under section 98(2)(b) of the IPA Constitution is not proven; and the case as presented under section 98(2)(f) of the IPA Constitution is not proven.
