(b) breached clause 98(2)(f) of the NIA Constitution in that it was alleged that the aforementioned conduct is not in the best interests of the Institute.

Tribunal Decision

The Disciplinary Tribunal resolved that the cases as presented under sections 98(2)(b) and 98(2)(f) of the NIA Constitution were proven.

The Tribunal further resolved that the member is admonished, without the name being published and costs of \$500.00 are applied, payable within 30 days.
