The NIA Investigations Review Officer and the NIA Investigations Officer resolved that the member had a case to answer for having breached clause 98(2)(h) of the NIA Constitution in that it was alleged the member failed to comply with a reasonable request made pursuant to a matter under this chapter of the Constitution in that although the member requested and was granted additional time to respond, the member failed to respond to reasonable requests of an Officer of the Institute.

Tribunal Decision
