The NIA Investigations Review Officer and the NIA Investigations Officer resolved that Mr. Cherry:

- (a) had a case to answer for having breached clause 98(2)(a) of the NIA Constitution in that it is alleged he was guilty of breaching the NIA Constitution, By-laws, Regulations or Pronouncements in that he failed to undertake a public practice quality assurance review as required of a member in public practice by Pronouncement 4 – Quality Assurance Reviews;
- (b) had a case to answer for having breached clause 98(2)(h) of the NIA Constitution in that it was alleged he failed to comply with a reasonable request of an officer of the Institute in that he did not respond to attempts to seek a response to the aforementioned issue; and
- (c) had a case to answer for having breached clause 98(2)(f) of the NIA Constitution in that it is alleged that the above is conduct that is not in the best interests of the Institute.

Tribunal Decision

The Tribunal resolved that the case against Mr. Cherry under NIA Constitution sections 98(2)(a); 98(2)(f); and 98(2)(h) were proven.

The Tribunal further resolved that Mr. Cherry's membership is forfeited and consequently he is to be struck off the NIA register of members and that Mr. Cherry contribute \$500.00 toward costs.
