## 2009 Complaints

In 2009 the IPA received 60 complaints Of these Thirty five (35) related to complaints about professional conduct, ten (10) Complaints related to members failing to have a Professional Practice Certificate, another ten (10) involved referrals from the ATO in relation to the audit of SMSF, four (4) cases were investigated as a result of breaches discovered as a result of a Professional practice Quality Assurance review (PPQA), one matter involved an ASIC ban on a member who was a liquidator and another matter came as a result of legal action taken against a member. One matter related to both an investigation in relation to professional conduct and a failure to abide by the IPA's professional requirements to have a PPC.

## Of the 60 matters in 2009, those finalised:
